The Installation Dance at the Shrine Center was well attended by our members and we are looking forward to an eventful and successful 2005.

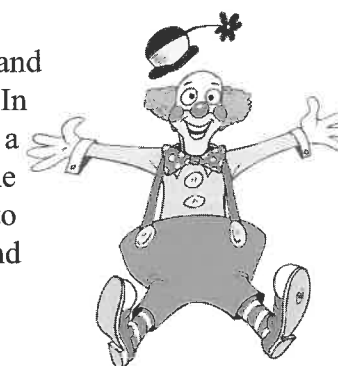

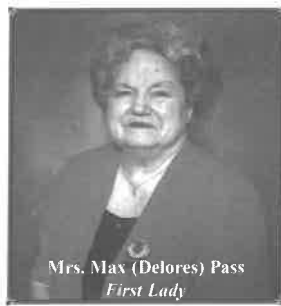
