

AL CHYMIA HISTORY

Since the creation of Al Chymia in 1891, the Temple has always been involved in the community affairs of Memphis and the other towns in west Tennessee either by invitation or volunteering our services.

In May, 1892, when the Frisco railroad bridge at Memphis, the first bridge across the Mississippi River south of St. Louis, was opened by President Grover Cleveland.

Al Chymia was asked to participate in the opening ceremonies And we supplied all the floats and the Mounted Patrol Headed by Captain William La-Croix led 27 mounted patrolmen across the bridge. The Potentate extended an invitation to President Cleveland to visit our open hospitality room at Al Chymia and he and his party accepted. At that time, Al Chymia was located at 40 Madison Avenue. For the bridge Opening celebration, Al Chymia kept the hospitality room Open for 2 days and nights.

In 1893, Al chymia entertained a group of Nobles and their ladies from Mecca Temple, New York, City who were returning from a pilgrimage to Mexico City. Al Chymia also entertained a group of Nobles and their ladies from Medina Temple, Chicago, Illinois.

In 1894, The initiation fees for the December Ceremonial was reduced from \$50 to \$25.
