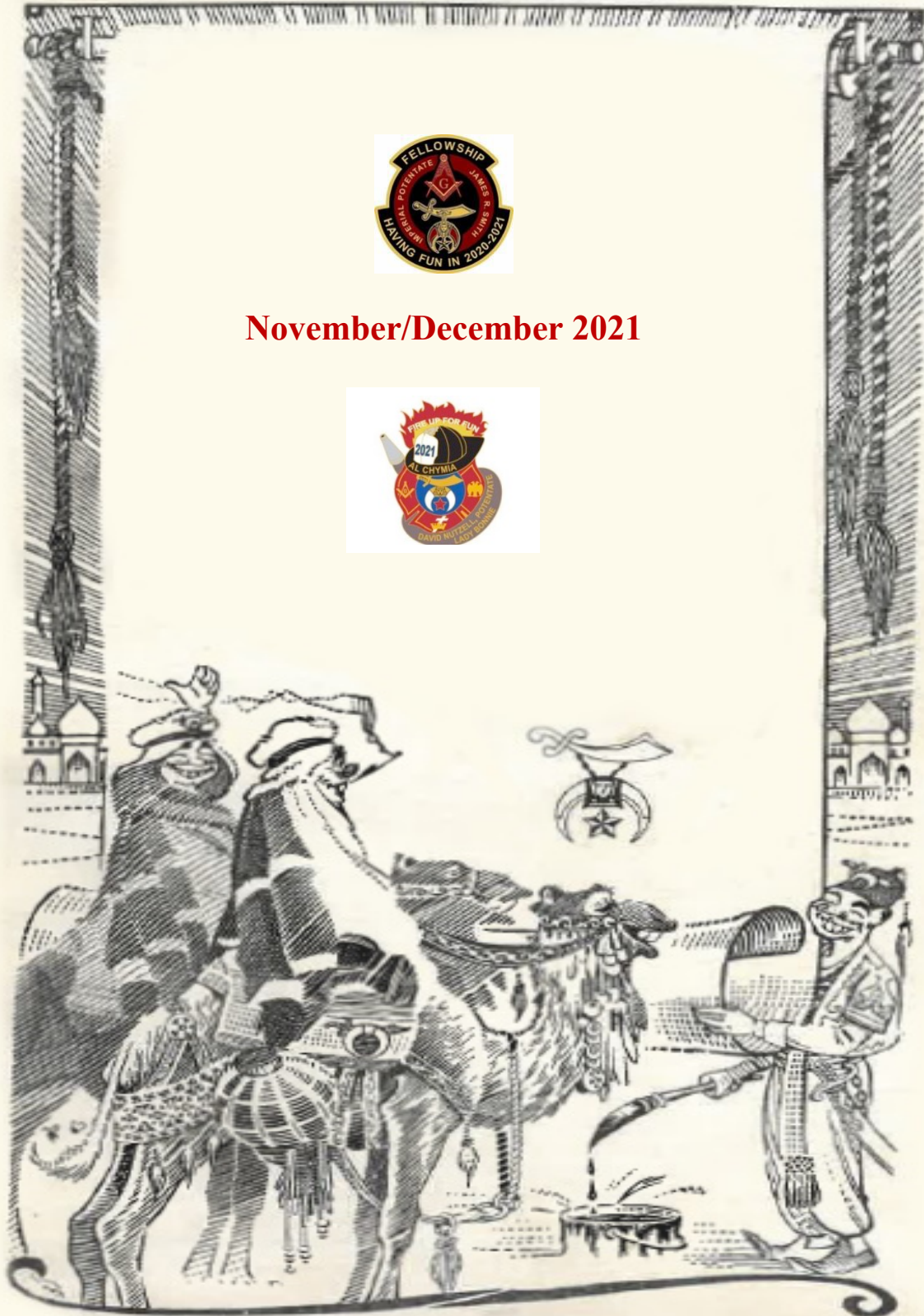

I just wanted to say thank you for allowing me to serve Al Chymia Shriners as Potentate. I have done the best I could for all Nobles of Al Chymia Shriners.

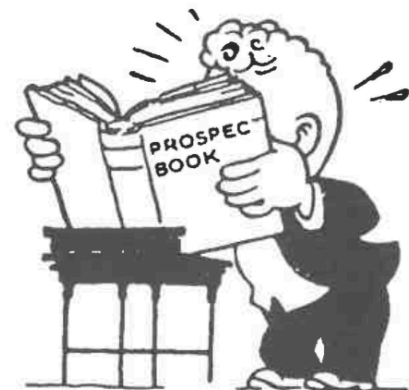

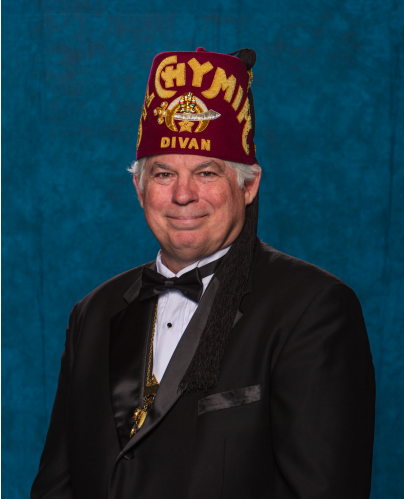
Hey Nobles,

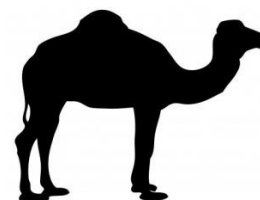

Crown of Honor

If you have a Crown of Honor, wear it. If you don't have one yet, earn it. If you earned a Crown of Honor and haven't received it yet, call or email Sparkie at sammysparks@yahoo.com or call or text 901-489-4161. Sign into Webfez.org for your points. The two important things to remember is that 4 hours of a event equals 100 points. So 1 hour is 25 points. The second thing is that you have to remember that the event must be sanctioned by Al Chymia and/or the Potentate. Stated meeting = 25 points, Parades = 100 points, St. louis trip is 300 points, Other locations drives are 400 points, The circus is 100 points per show, Working at the temple is 25 points an hour. Whether it is the old building or the new building, Peddling tickets, flyers, paper drive = 25 points an hour, The Potentate may give points where he sees fit, Working screenings = 100 points, First line signer = 200 points, Second line signer = 100 points, If a children you get to the screening and they become a Shriners Kid = 500 points

St. Louis Hospital Report

Nobles of Al Chymia,

We are excited to announce that the all-new [shrinerschildrens.org](https://www.shrinerschildrens.org) is live. Shriners Children's is proud to introduce this complete digital transformation of our website to our nobles and extended Shriners family. The new site enhances user experience, streamlines content and improves search engine optimization. Patient families, providers and donors are now able to get the content they are looking for faster on this easy-to-navigate website. Requesting an appointment, making a donation and finding information is easier than ever.

We encourage all nobles to explore the website and to help us spread the word about the new [shrinerschildrens.org](https://www.shrinerschildrens.org) website. **It is easier than ever for a family to research our system and set up appointments.** <https://www.shrinerschildrens.org/en/locations/st-louis> will take you directly to the St. Louis site.

New Patient Appointment Requests process There are two appointment request web forms and one provider referral request web form on the new website.

- From the Appointments and Admissions page, users can choose which web form to use, New or Existing. The Existing Patient information includes the option to log in to the patient portal to request an appointment.
- From the *For Healthcare Professionals* page and from the *I Want To Find* menu, providers can access the new referral web form. This is important as we are receiving more referrals from healthcare providers and insurance companies.
- There are also a number of referral and request appointment calls-to-action throughout the website.

You will notice that our hospital in St. Louis is now referred to as Shriners Childrens St.Louis. The overall organization brand for the entire system is still Shriners Hospitals for Children and each location will now have its own locale identity. This is due to the fact that under the term “hospital” a location must meet certain requirements. Since some of our locations are outpatient surgery centers, they cannot use the term “hospital” in their names. St. Louis still qualifies as a hospital as we have inpatient facilities.

St. Louis is almost up to the same patient load as pre pandemic and is still practicing restrictions according to CDC and state and local requirements to ensure the safety of our patients and staff.

The staff and board of St. Louis is extremely grateful for the generosity of the Al Chymia Temple for the donations received enabling us to keep helping kids to be kids.

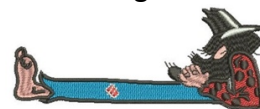

At the beginning of the year of 2021, it looked as if we were never going to be able to survive or function. When we would meet to eat and plan, there would be 8-10 present plus visitors. Now there only two of us.

However, as bleak as things seem to look, God gives a little hope and opens a window. As I began to think about closing the club, I thought I would give it the old college try to keep it alive. I started with going around to the banks as Clancy and Giles used to do and see if I could raise a little money for the hospital fund. I would get \$25 here and \$100 there. After visiting one bank in particular, I learned the next day that my conversation with that bank official was relayed to an individual about me collecting money for the Shriners hospital for children. I received a phone call from that individual who wondered if they could donate to the hospital fund from their father's estate. I advised that I would be happy to take their donation. Expecting a small amount as I had been collecting, I was caught off guard when they informed me they would like to donate \$10,000 dollars. They asked how they could get the check to the proper authority but would rather not place it in the mail. I advised them I would make a phone call and get back to them. I called our recorder and told him of my situation. As I spoke with him the donor called and wondered if I could take it personally to the proper authorities. I told them I would, but it would have to be today. I told Noble Taylor that I would acquire the check by noon and that I would arrive around 2:30 at the office. Noble Taylor gathered everyone together including Noble brothers Nutzell (Potentate) and Williams (Treasurer) at which time I presented the check to them.

The Lord provides in many ways to a need, and I was very humbled by Him using me as a means of providing for that need.

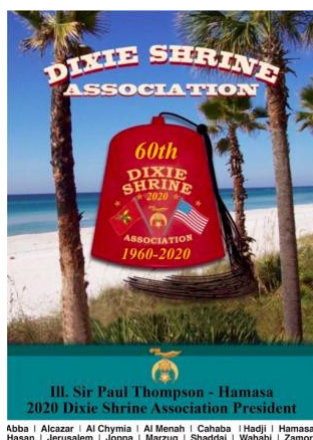
